You're	You are
Your(s)	It belongs to you
They're	They are
Their(s)	It belongs to them
There	A location
We're	We are
Were	Past tense of are (example: They WERE very hungry)
Then	A point in time (example: Life was simpler back THEN)
Than	A comparison (example: Jim is taller THAN Brian)
Two	A number
To	Expressing motion (example: I'm going TO the grocery store)
Too	Also or excessively (example: I was up TOO late studying)
